



MOBILISING UNIVERSITY-COMMUNITY RESOURCES THROUGH SL(M) FOR THE INCLUSION OF MIGRANTS/REFUGEES

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The project is co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.

Our purpose is to bring together the academic world and social agents to work on an intercultural educational project that favours the processes of inclusion of migrants/refugees in Europe, training future professionals and their teachers in ethnic and cultural diversity, and involving everyone in community projects that contribute to the development of common values and civic engagement of all participants. In addition, innovation in the teaching-learning process at the university will be promoted through the service-learning methodology.

The duration of the project is 36 months and its period of implementation runs from 1st of September 2022 to 31st of August 2025.

OBJETIVE

The main objective is to create alliances between host community groups and third country nationals in order to form national support networks that will interconnect with each other.

It involves the collaboration between different areas of knowledge of the University as it is sought that the service-learning projects are developed in different degrees (Medicine, Education, Pharmacy, Law, Engineering,...) depending on the needs detected.

TARGET GROUPS

Migrants/refugees:

Each Service-Learning (SL) project will focus on a specific group or groups (children, women, young people, adults,...). They are involved in the project and participate in its planning.

University students:

From different degrees. Students will find in the subject syllabus that the teaching methodology includes a European SL(M) project.

Technical staff from partners organizations:


Professionals directly involved with migrants/refugees, who know their needs and expectations.


University teachers:


From different areas of knowledge.

WORKPACKAGES

- WP 1: Project management.
- WP 2: Design, implementation and evaluation of a course on SL and migration/refuge for teachers and university students (basic training).
- WP 3: Design of university-entity SL(M) projects.
- WP 4: Implementation of SL(M) projects in each community.
- WP 5: Final evaluation of the SL(M) projects.
